I. General Provisions

1. The Organizer of the Series

3. Entries

For entry of swimmer's events, relays and staff use the attached Excel entry form.

The relay entry by name shall be done at least one hour before the commencement of the appropriate swimming session.

Closing date for entries: 20th Apr, 2025

Any later changes in the submitted event entries shall not be accepted. Athletes may only be withdrawn from the entire session.

4. Entry Fees, Accommodation, Board, Transportation

The entry fee: 50EUR/person that includes a two-day race with three sessions, a Sat packed lunch, Sat dinner, transportation during the event and after party Sat evening with free use of the waterpark attractions (water slides, lazy river, and Jacuzzi).

Accommodation and Board

The organizer can arrange for Fri and Sat accommodation including breakfast, Fri dinner at the Hotel Duo in the form of dinner buffet (25 EUR), accommodation (50EUR per person per night in a triple room, 60 EUR in a double/twin room, 105 EUR in a single room).

Bookings and Fri dinner reservations (total number) must be placed by Mar 26th, 2025 via email of the Organising Committee at ppp@paraplavanipraha.cz.

On-site transportation between the Hotel Duo and the Šutka waterpark is provided by wheelchair accessible buses. Alternatively, you can use public transportation – the wheelchair accessible buses no. 152 or 177. The nearest bus stop to the Šutka Waterpark is Čimický háj and the nearest bus stop to the Hotel Duo is Střížkov). The buses go every 5-10 minutes, and the journey takes approximately 12 minutes. The hotel parking fee and the pool parking fee are covered by the Organiser.

5. On-Site Registration and Warm-Up

On-site registration is on Fri, 25th Apr, 2025 in the Šutka Waterpark lobby: 16:15.

Warm up: Fri 17:00 – 17:40, Sat 9:00 – 9:40

During the break between the Sat Morning and Sat Afternoon Sessions (13:00 – 13:45), cool-down and warm-up are possible.

Lane 1 will be allocated only for one-way dive start, start from the platform (only 25m, at 25m a moveable pool divider/bulkhead will be installed). The other half of the pool will be used for turn practice. Each club is responsible for their swimmer's safety.

Lane 7 will be allocated for swimmers in classes S11-S12.

Lane 8 will be allocated for swimmers in classes S1-4.

II. *Technical provisions*

1. **Governing Regulations**

The competition takes place in a long course (50 m) pool with Automatic officiating equipment in accordance with the international WPS Rules and Regulations, the 2025 Czech Cup Regulations and the entry information hereof. Protests must be submitted in accordance with the WPS Rules and Regulations. Results of swimmers holding a valid World Para Swimming Athlete License are entered into the World Rankings List in accordance with the WPS Rules and Regulations.

2. **Competition Format and Protocol**

The competition comprises of three sessions stretched over two days, the first session (Fri) is only 50m freestyle men and women – preliminary heats. It is also the only event with preliminary heats and finals (finals will be swum at the beginning of the Sat morning session from 10:00). Official times taken in all other heats are considered final times. The final order of swimmers in each event is established in accordance with the point score system of German Paralympic Swimming (except for 50m freestyle, the order of all sports classes and age categories together, man and women separately), is listed for each event. The preliminary 50m freestyle event is swum men and women separately. Results will be published in the same fashion as in all other events. Eight best swimmers in each age category will swim in the finals.

3. **The Victory Ceremony**

Eight best swimmers from each Fri preliminary 50m freestyle age group (Pupils, Juniors, Adults male, Adults female, Masters) will swim in the Sat finals. First three places in each age category will be awarded during the Victory Ceremony that will take place at the beginning the Sat afternoon session. The duathlon victory ceremony will take place at the end of the competition, i.e. after the 4x50m medley relay at the pool starting platform. The duathlon is calculated in accordance with the Czech Cup Regulation. The best point performance of the competition will also be awarded. Dinner will be served at the pool after the victory ceremony from 18:30 to 20:45, you can enjoy live music and entertainment available at the water park. The pool must be vacated by 21:00.

4. **For Your Attention**

Only athletes with a valid (international or national) classification may enter the race. Athletes without a valid classification or not meeting the minimum impairment requirements starts in the AB Class. The LOC reserves the right to limit the number of entries when the pool capacity has been met. Entry to the facility/pool deck is only allowed to those who have changed their clothing and footwear. All wheelchairs must be equipped with tyre covers (available at the reception desk of the pool). Spectators may watch the competition from the upper deck of the stands - entrance fee voluntary.
